B(i) — On the A-side, the T of "Eight" is slightly to the right of the middle stem of the W in "Week." There is a blank line between the publishing credit and BMI — 2:43. On the B-side the T of "Don't" is centered over the "S" in "Spoil," and the word "I" is over the space between "NT" in "Want."

B(ii) — On the A-side, the T of "Eight" is slightly to the right of the middle stem of the W in "Week." There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI — 2:43. On the B-side the first line is further to the right than in B(i).

B(iii) – On the A-side, the T of "Eight" is slightly to the left of the middle stem of the W in "Week." There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43. On the B-side the first line is in between its locations in B(i) and B(ii).

B(iv) – On the A-side, the T of "Eight" is centered over the middle stem of the W in "Week." There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43.

Picture sleeve PS1A (east coast):

The sleeve is cut straight across the top on both sides. The open side of the sleeve has "Eight Days a Week" on top.

Picture sleeve PS1B (west coast):


