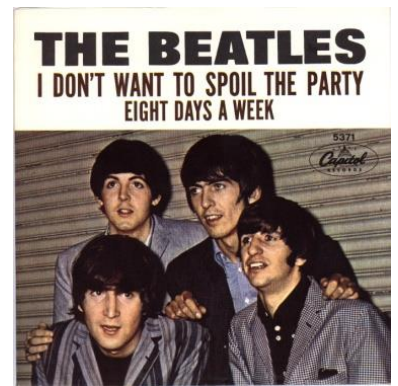

01A (Keystone print)

Factories: Scranton, RCA Rockaway, Decca Pinckneyville

A(i) – On the A-side, the center of the word “A” is under the center of the “G” in EIGHT; on the B-side the left base in the W of WANT lies entirely over the E in THE.

A(ii) – On the A-side, the center of the word “A” is under the right side of the “G” in EIGHT; on the B-side the left base in the W of WANT lies over the HE in THE.



01B (Bert-Co print)

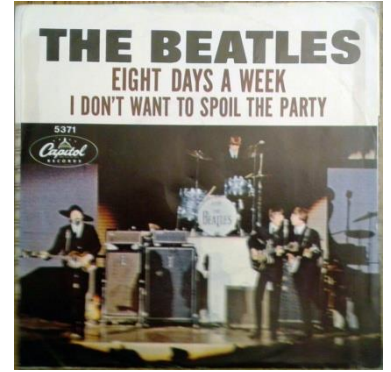
Factories: Los Angeles

B(i) – On the A-side, the T of “Eight” is slightly to the right of the middle stem of the W in “Week.” There is a blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43. On the B-side the T of “Don’t” is centered over the “S” in “Spoil,” and the word “I” is over the space between “NT” in “Want.”

B(ii) – On the A-side, the T of “Eight” is slightly to the right of the middle stem of the W in “Week.” There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43. On the B-side the first line is further to the right than in B(i).

B(iii) – On the A-side, the T of “Eight” is slightly to the left of the middle stem of the W in “Week.” There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43. On the B-side the first line is in between its locations in B(i) and B(ii).

B(iv) – On the A-side, the T of “Eight” is centered over the middle stem of the W in “Week.” There is no blank line between the publishing credit and BMI – 2:43.



**Picture sleeve PS1A (east coast):**

The sleeve is cut straight across the top on both sides. The open side of the sleeve has “Eight Days a Week” on top.

**Picture sleeve PS1B (west coast):**

The sleeve is tab cut. The tab is on the side with “Eight Days a Week” at the top.

Orange/yellow swirl label with subsidiary print in white.

October, 1968, to April, 1969

Factory: Scranton

The titles appear in the same print as on the earlier Keystone pressing.



**Label 69a**

Capitol 5371

Red/orange target label with “C” logo. There is no white dot on the backdrop behind the Capitol logo.

July, 1969, to October, 1970

Factory: Scranton (69aS)

The titles appear in the same print as on the earlier Keystone pressing.

Factory: Los Angeles (69aL<sub>1</sub>, below left)

Wide (Bert-Co) typeface. The top line reads “Eight Days.”

Factories: Scranton (69aL<sub>2</sub>, below right)

Wide typeface. The top line reads “Eight.”

Label may have “TM” next to the Capitol logo, or may have ® under the “l” of “Capitol,” or may have ® to the right of the “l” in “Capitol.”

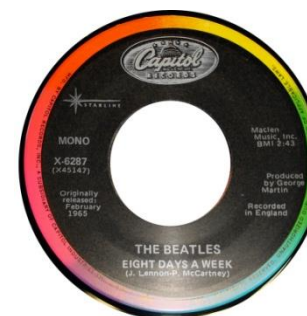
