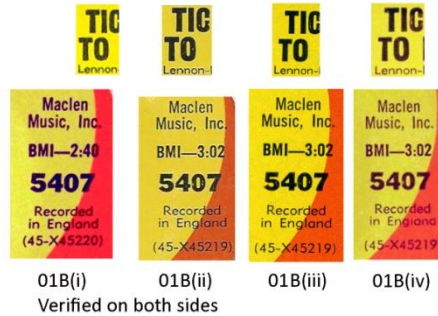

B(iii) – On the A-side, the T of “TO” is over the en of “Lennon.” There is a blank line above the matrix number.

B(iv) – On the A-side, the T of “TO” is over the e of “Lennon.” There is a blank line above the matrix number.

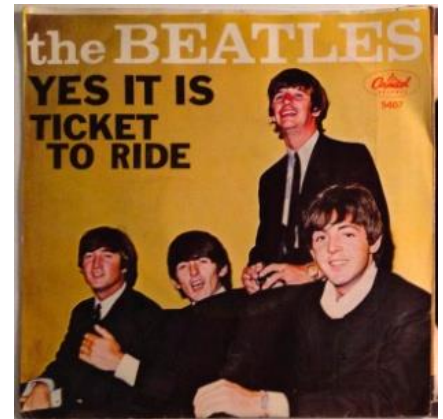
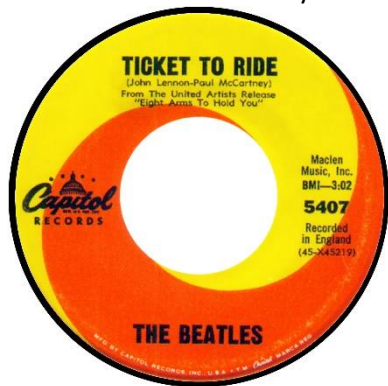

The sleeve is cut straight across the top on both sides. The open side of the sleeve has "Yes it Is" on top. Scarce.

**Picture sleeve PS1B (west coast):**

The sleeve is tab cut. The tab is on the side with "Ticket to Ride" at the top.

Apple 5407  
Apple label with rights information on one or both sides.  
Factory: Los Angeles arL  
Rights information appears at the top of the A-side label.  
Factory: Jacksonville  
Darker label??



**Label 72r1**

Capitol 5407  
Orange label with rights disclaimer  
Factory: Los Angeles  
"Capitol" is in olive green on LA copies, and MONO is on the label.  
Factory: Winchester  
"Capitol" is in tan, and MONO does not appear.

Capitol 5407

Purple label with large logo; rim text starts with "MFD."

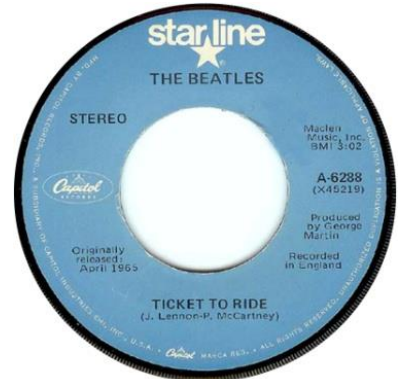

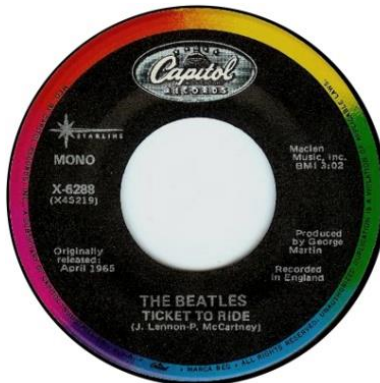
