The emphasis is away from musical and lyrical complexities. Of all the songs that will pull airplay, the title song and "The Fool on the Hill" should be the most appealing. The other side is comprised of their singles hits.

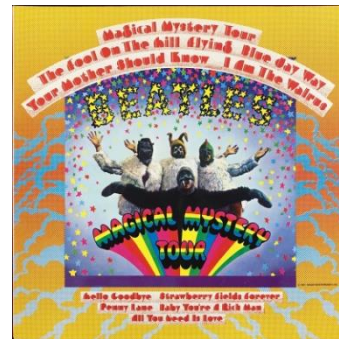
