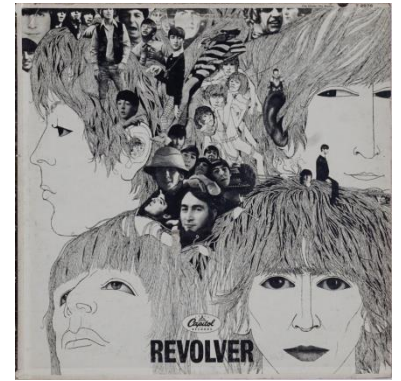

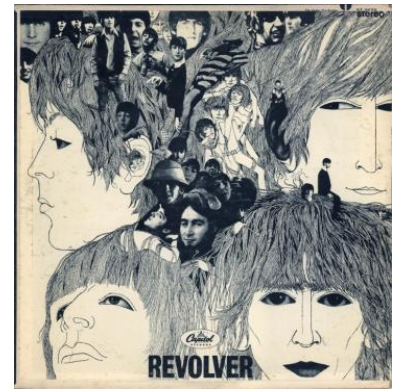

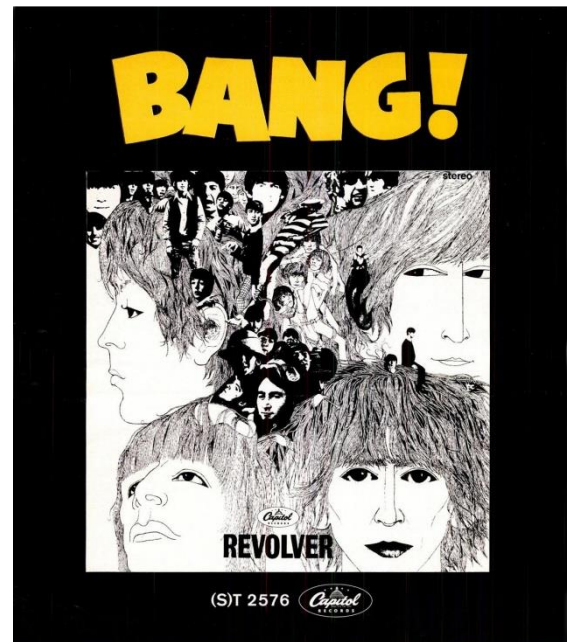

Cover without the catalog number in the upper right; back cover wrapped around is black.

Copies pressed in 1974-5 have "Mastered by Capitol" in the matrix.



Possible covers: Later covers from Jacksonville have no "File Under" information or catalog number; instead, the black back simply folds over to the front.

Some copies have a sticker on the shrink wrap reading "SW." This indicates the new LP prefix (and price code).
