The print on LA singles is slightly larger than the print on Scranton singles, and the printing is positioned slightly differently. For example, on side A the "y" in "McCartney" in the production credit is over the N in JOHN on the east-coast labels; that "y" is over the F in FOSTER on the west-coast labels.

The A-side is the theme song from "Thingumybob" (also written as "Thingumy Bob") – a television series starring Stanley Holloway; the lead character's name is Bob.
