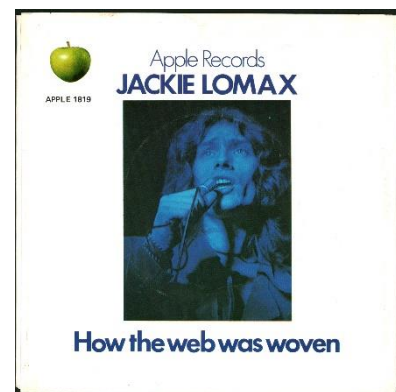
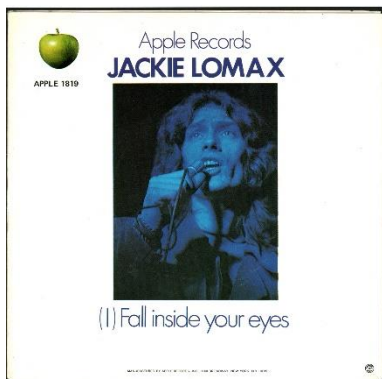

 One of the premiere artists in Apple's singles area, Jackie Lomax drew recognition with "The Eagle" and "Sour Milk Sea." Now he moves toward FM consideration with this new performance. Flip: "(I) Fall Inside Your Eyes" (3:12) (Apple, BMI — Lomax) Once again his "B" side is the more commercial.
