The greatest all-star line-up of raga players got back together at Carnegle Hall for a concert in memoriam of the recently deceased music teacher Ustad Allauddin Khan. As always the music made by Rawi Shankar, Ali Akbar Khan and Alla Rakha is fiery and hypnotic. This release will presumably get more promotional impetus than some of the artists' recent releases and may well be the best-selling raga record of recent years.

Note: the album sides were sequenced as 1/4/2/3, play together on the same turntable.

Ravi Shankar and Ali Akbar Khan played together at the New York Philharmonic on October 8, 1972. Alan Steckler recorded the concert for future releasee, George Harrison mixed the recorded performance of the two great masters, and Apple released the record. Perhaps testing the waters with an American release, Apple held back a British release of the album until April.
