


Badfinger carries on the rhythm-happy tradition of the early Beatles, rocking to the big beat without hang-ups or pretensions of profundity. Pete Ham and Joey Molland write most of the group's original material, but songs, as well as the Liverpool-type voices, cover the Beatles like a Xerox. The catch is they're good, and prove it nicely on "No Matter What," "Better Days," "Without You" and "I Can't Take It."





Side two is the same on each of the above records as it is on the 3:42 pressing. At some point in late 1970, someone at Capitol Records recognized that 3:42 was not the correct song time and ordered it corrected. This change seems to have occurred at the approximate time when Winchester began using labels that have "MFD. BY APPLE" on the full side.

Following their first chart album that featured the music from "The Magic Christian," Badfinger returns with their second LP effort that includes their hit single, "No Matter What," and eleven other rockin' numbers among which are "I Can't Take It," "We're For The Dark," "Love Me Do," (no relation to the Beatles version) "It Had To Be," and "Better Days."




