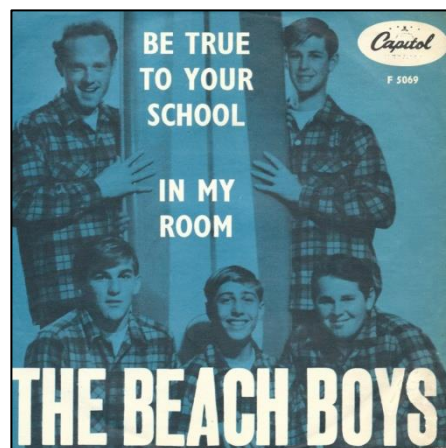

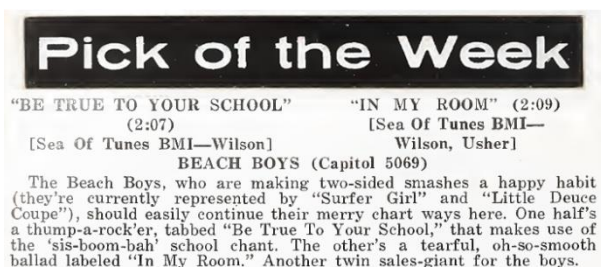

Based on the matrix numbers, and on the fact that Capitol had promoted the inclusion of “In My Room” on the *Surfer Girl* album, that song was intended as the A-side when the single went to radio stations. However, it was quickly apparent that “Be True to Your School” was getting more traction. *Billboard* first mentioned the single in its October 19, 1963, issue, and it debuted in the issue dated November 2 – peaking at #6 right before Christmas. *Cash Box* marked it as the Pick of the Week on October 19th and took it as high as #8.

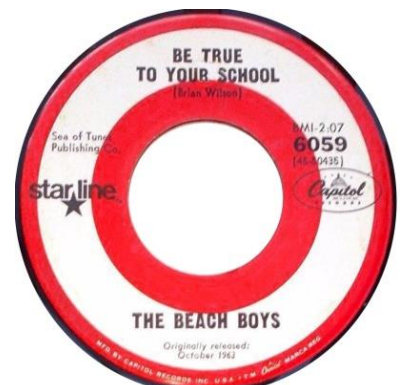
