

Label O1L(iii) has four blank lines on each side in the credits: above BMI, below BMI, above Produced by, and above the date code.


Label 01L(iv) has two blank lines on each side in the credits: above BMI, and below BMI. This label is probably later, c. 1965-66.

Label 01L(v) has no blank lines. It definitely came out later, c. 1968, as some copies have the label on copies of the single with the no-slip ridges that were added in the middle of that year.

Cash Box reviewed the new record in its May 16, 1964, issue – which also featured an ad from Capitol. Billboard introduced the single at the same time, so that the release date on the label (May 11) is likely correct. The record bounded up the charts rapidly, giving the Beach Boys their first #1 hit.






