

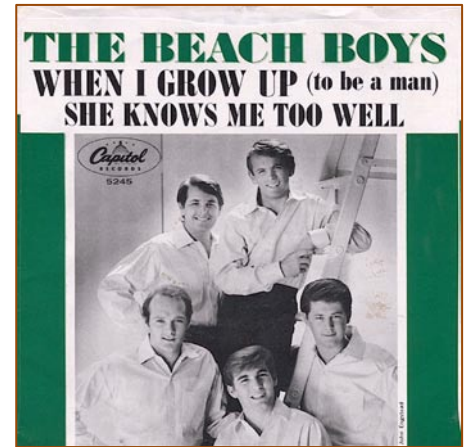

Label 01L(i) has the line on side A reading “Arranged by Brian Wilson” underneath half of the H of THE and underneath the Y of BOYS. Additionally, there is no blank line above the Brian Wilson credit.

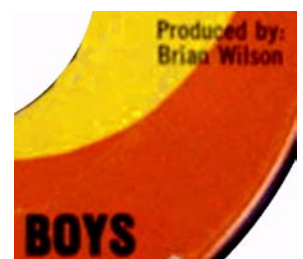
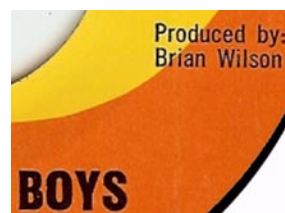
Label 01L(ii) has the line on side A reading “Arranged by Brian Wilson” underneath half of the H of THE and underneath the Y of BOYS. Additionally, there is a blank line above the Brian Wilson credit, and there is more space above the artist name.

Label 01L(iii) has the line on side A reading “Arranged by Brian Wilson” further to the right under the H of THE and further to the left under the Y of BOYS; the whole line is narrower. Additionally, there are a few lines of space above the artist name.

Label 01L(iv) has the line on side A reading “Arranged by Brian Wilson” further to the right under the H of THE and further to the left under the Y of BOYS; the whole line is narrower. Additionally, there is more space above the artist name.

The Beach Boys, who are coming off a tremendous double-decker in the chart-topping “I Get Around” and “Don’t Worry Baby,” should soon zoom skywards once again with this duo. On the leadoff portion they ask what would happen “When I Grow Up To Be A Man”—in the jumpin’ rhythmic manner that has made them such big teen favorites. Coupler’s a captivating cha cha beat romancer that’s also sure to please the kids.



The record first appeared in *Billboard* in the issue dated September 5, 1964; it debuted the following week and soon rose to #9. In *Cash Box* the single was reviewed in the August 29th issue, and then it hit the airwaves. Debuting in the September 12th issue, the single achieved the #7 position.

Apparently Queens Litho was busy with other printing jobs, because the east-coast picture sleeves have a different cut than any other Beach Boys sleeves. These have a slight tab on the open side that looks more like a wavy top.



Picture Sleeve

PS1A(east coast):

The sleeve has a wavy top on the open side. The colors are in a shade of dull green, or light green.

PS1A(a) has "When I Grow Up" on top on the open side of the sleeve.

PS1A(b) has "She Knows Me too Well" on top on the open side of the sleeve.

PS1B (west coast):

The sleeve is tab cut. The colors are in a shade of blue, including sky blue and a dull ("turquoise") blue.

"When I Grow Up" on top on the open side of the sleeve.



Red Vinyl One-Off Contract Pressing

This record, and possibly others like it, was pressed by an employee of the RCA-Hollywood plant using metal parts from Capitol's Los Angeles plant. Unlike the other copies pressed by RCA-Hollywood, this one is on red vinyl. It is unlikely that Capitol authorized the pressing on red vinyl, but they probably would not have cared, either.



The matrix information for this copy is as follows.

A-side: 45-52666-F1 4 * W

B-side: 45-52667-F1 6 * W

The lone number, the LA factory symbol, and the W (at the time, the factory symbol of the RCA-Hollywood plant) are machine stamped.

While this is a genuine product of a plant that was authorized to press the record, Capitol certainly did not authorize the red pressing. Most likely a factory worker made it for himself as a keepsake.
