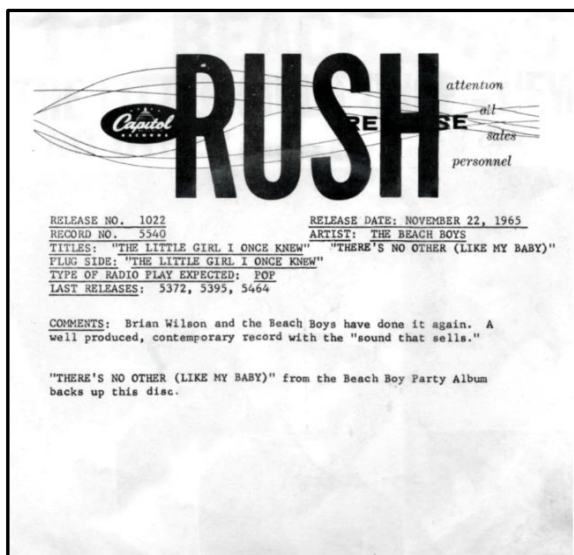

Cash Box and *Billboard* each reviewed the rush-released single in their November 20, 1965, issues. Although it received positive reviews, the radio stations largely ignored it – preferring instead one of the songs from the promotional EP for the *Party* album. It peaked briefly at #20 on *Billboard* and at #15 on *Cash Box* before sliding back down the charts. Capitol soon removed it from the catalog.



Picture Sleeve

PS1A(east coast):

The sleeve has a straight-cut top. The open side and larger side feature the same graphics.

PS1B (west coast):

The sleeve is tab cut. The tab side and the other side feature the same graphics.

The picture sleeves show the B-side title (incorrectly) as "No Other (Like My Baby)."
