

This remix of "California Saga" is quite different from the version that appears on the *Holland* LP. Rob Fraboni created it especially for release as a single, but it did not fare so well on the charts. Record World picked it up immediately (April 28th) at #140, letting it creep up the 101 to 150 chart until May 26th, when it finally reached #99. *Cash Box* omitted it until May 19th, putting it first at 111 and then at 110 on the 26th. *Billboard* favored the song more than the others, picking it up at #91 on May 12th and elevating it to the #84 position on June 2nd before allowing it to drop out.
