Those Crazy Cover Numbers

Over the years, Capitol Records contracted with almost two dozen companies to print blackand-white back covers for their albums. Each company indicated that they had printed any given cover by means of a small number located either at the bottom left side or the bottom right side of the back cover. Since some of these "cover numbers" appeared for a short time and only with covers that were sent to specific Capitol factories, it is often possible to determine – based on the number that appears – approximately when the album cover was printed. We generally believe that for all LP's except *Revolver*, a black-and-white back slick that does not show any cover number indicates that Capitol or RCA printed some covers in-house for that LP. The Scranton plant pressed no reissue LP's from early-1969 on.



Generally speaking, these cover numbers are associated with the time frames shown in the table below:
