

# Nicaraguan Pressings of Beatles Records

## 1966-1973

### Capitol Swirl Label Singles and Rainbow Label LPs

(1966 to mid-1967)



When Nicaragua began to release the Beatles' catalog in 1966, Capitol's label in Nicaragua was new – just as they had recently opened operations in Mexico. By the middle of 1967, Sonido Industrial diversified, and the Beatles were placed on the Odeon label.

## Orange Odeon Label

(late 1970 to 1972)



No new Beatles records came out on the orange label, but quite a few solo records appeared on the orange label, including “What is Life” (O1-0557) and “Another Day” (O1-0565).

## Apple Label With Dark Green Background

(late 1972 [single 0650] to early 1975)



New Beatles LPs did appear on the Apple label, but all of the Beatles singles that came out during this period were reissues of earlier records. However, there were quite a few solo singles on Apple.
