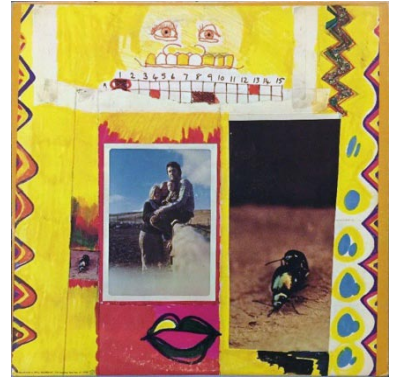

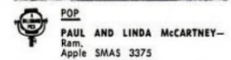
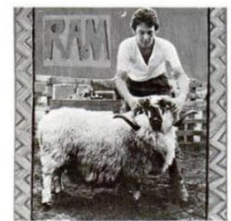

A good part of the fun is McCartney's light, clever arrangements and superb rhythm changes. "Smile Away," "Too Many People" and "Back Seat of My Car" are wailing sentimentality. Denny Seiwell, Dave Spinoza and Hugh McCracken anchor the sound.

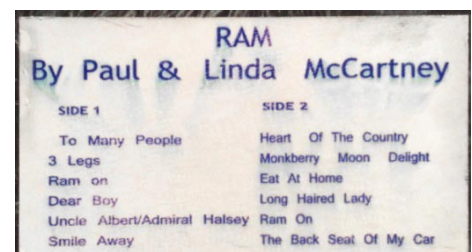

Capitol Records had been using labels that read "Mfd. by Apple Records Inc." on side 2. In spring, 1971, they decided to use up those labels and to replace them with labels having "Mfd. by Apple" on the full side. Paul himself appears to have requested that this LP have two unsliced Apple labels, but this may not be the case. After using up the sliced-side labels, Capitol added "Mfd. by Apple" across one side of their remaining stock of full-side labels.
