In June, 1960, Capitol revised the statement about monophonic albums that appears at the bottom of the back cover. The revised wording is briefer.

This monophonic microgroove recording is playable on monophonic and stereo phonographs. It cannot become obsolete. It will continue to be a source of outstanding sound reproduction, providing the finest monophonic performance from any phonograph.

### **Capitol Introduces the Star Line**

In May, 1960, Capitol brought out its new Star Line of reissue releases, consisting at first of four albums from the existing catalog and eleven new greatest-hits compilations. Each album in the Star Line sported a metallic gold label.

At first both the previously-released albums and the new compilations sported back covers that were unique to the release, but in 1961 and 1962, the Star Line releases used a common back cover design depicting other records that were available in the series.

The Star Line expanded in December, 1961, to include singles as well and became an effective method for Capitol to make available material from the back catalog. All of Capitol's biggest stars – such as Frank Sinatra, the Beatles, Nat "King" Cole, and the Beach Boys – had releases in the Star Line.
