In addition to the new Dauntless product, there are five new A-F releases, one of which will be a special, music box Christmas LP, to be sold at the low price of \$2.98.

The package will be merchandised in a self-contained counter display, pre-pak carton and will be advertised to consumers at the special price.



This album was recorded by members of the group who rode in buses around the South protesting segregation laws. Several of the singers had been released from jail shortly before they recorded for this album.









Sid Frey began importing records from Israel in 1948. Within four years, the company called Dauntless International was also releasing historical albums on the Audio Archives label. It was Dauntless that became known as the distributor for Frey's Audio Fidelity label when it started up in late 1954. So it was Dauntless that became Audio Fidelity's new subsidiary label in 1962. Although the label only lasted for about a year, several of the recordings became known as sought-after classics.
