



There was no American picture sleeve for this single; however, when Wings was in West Berlin for a concert on March 23, 1976, Paul and Linda added the song title to a bed sheet, and the band walked around town holding up the banner. "Checkpoint Charlie" was the endpoint of the walk. One of the photographs was selected, and artwork was created for advertising, and for picture sleeves in other countries. Had there been a picture sleeve in the United States, it probably would have used these graphics.
